Stroud Public Schools along with Five Star Interlocal Co-op Public Schools believe all children have the right to a free and appropriate education. This is mandated by the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), formerly known as Public Law 94-142. This federal law provides for all children with disabilities from birth to age twenty-one who may be in need of special education services. This may include children who are: Developmentally Delayed, Intellectually Disabled, Learning Disabled, Hearing Impaired or Deaf, Blind or Partially Sighted, Emotionally Disturbed, Autistic, Traumatic Brain Injured, Other Health Impaired, Multiply Disabled, Speech or Language Impaired or Physically Disabled.

Stroud Public Schools and Five Star Interlocal Co-op Public School Districts are interested in locating and identifying children with disabilities who are not currently receiving services. We offer such services as educational and psychological evaluations, counseling, speech and language evaluations in addition to basic services provided by the schools. Services are provided at no cost to the parent.

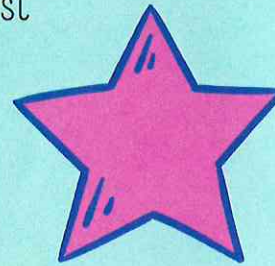

The Five Star Interlocal Cooperative is dedicated to serving the individual with disabilities, complying with IDEA and Section 504 in 12 rural school districts in five Oklahoma counties:

Creek, Lincoln, Payne, Pawnee, and Okfuskee.

First priority is to serve students, ages three through twelve years of public school education, with significant disabilities who require ongoing, extensive support in more than one major life activity in order to enjoy the quality of life and learning available to people with fewer or no disabilities.

Our second priority is to serve the student who is most at risk for being excluded from the general educational setting.

Our goal is to continue to expand our efforts to identify and provide special education and related services for individuals with disabilities.



Serving over 250 children in portions of 5 counties.

Eighteen Co-op classrooms have been established in 4 districts to serve those individuals between the ages of 3-21 who are in need of an Individualized Educational Program.

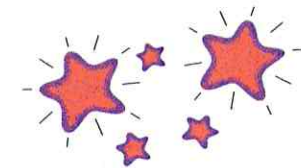
