Access to Materials

Almost all material is on open shelves, and each student may borrow two items for a period of two weeks. Exceptions to this limit need to be cleared with the librarian. Reference materials and video programs remain in the library. Computers are reserved for academic work during school hours. Internet users must have a signed *Internet Use Agreement* on file in the principal's office. A fine of \$0.5 (five cents) per item, per school day is charged for late returns. Readers are responsible for the replacement cost of lost or damaged materials.

Orderly Conduct

In a world of increasing noise and stress, libraries are a haven of peace and order and they should be. For that reason, each person is requested to act in an orderly way. No one is allowed to eat, drink, write on furniture, put his feet on the furniture, talk continuously, sleep or loiter in the library.

Compliance with General Regulations

All visitors are expected to comply with these regulations. Anyone who violated them or in any other way disturbs a fellow reader or member of the staff will be asked to leave. Willful or continued violations may result in exclusion from the library.
