Dear School Patrons:

We are making many plans on several levels for our entire District each day. Next week is an important week for our school as we celebrate our Seniors with the Senior Awards Monday, June 1st and Graduation on Friday, June 5th. We have given great consideration to the conditions of our time and have developed plans for operations and attendance at these events.

The Senior Awards Program starts at 7 PM at the Stroud High School PAC. To meet social distancing guidelines, we have limited seating and spacing as appropriate for our Seniors and a four member contingent of their family members. Seniors will identify those family members for our staff prior to entry into the PAC. Seating will be on a first come first serve basis for those guests. There will seating available on a four person basis for our graduates. Those seats will be together, but spaced away from other groups of four maintaining social distancing guidelines of six ft. The event will be livestreamed for all other interested parties to watch as we honor our graduates. A waiver will be signed by those attendees as a part of attendance at this event. A copy of this waiver is a part of this message. We will have copies at the entrance for quick completion. The version you see here is for your review prior to your arrival. This event is voluntary for all parties involved.

Senior Graduation is scheduled for Friday, June 5th starting at 7 PM. at the Stroud Route 66 Coliseum. To meet social distancing guidelines, we have limited seating for this event also. Each graduate is allowed up to fifteen family members for attendance. The fifteen family members will be seated in a row of fifteen seats for that set of guests for a particular graduate only. Fifteen tickets will be provided for each graduate for their contingent. A parent of each graduate will be given a packet of tickets personalized to each graduate for admission to be distributed in their specific group. Graduate families will be seated in one specific row as a family group. Seating in the Coliseum will be spaced at six feet spacing requirements between rows. Individual family members will be seated side by side. Waiver forms will be provided in the ticket packet for completion by each individual prior to entry into the Coliseum. Family seating per row will be on a first come first serve basis. The event will be livestreamed for all interested parties who do not have access to the Coliseum due to distancing requirements. This event is voluntary for all parties involved.

We have worked diligently to provide a quality event for our Seniors and their families. We ask for your cooperation in maintaining distancing requirements within the plan as designed. We will have additional information next week regarding the graduation event to provide details of ticket

distribution, building opening times, etc. A graduation production developed in lieu of a live graduation will be released after the ceremony for your viewing as well.

The requirements for events change quickly at times. Please understand this approach is our plan, but it is subject to change prior to each of these events.
