

Stroud High School Distance Learning Launch Information

1. Students will access their curriculum through Google Classroom. This will require logging in with their student email. Each student will receive their email when they pick up a device or by calling the school on the day of checkout. (918) 968-2542. This is the same email they have used all year. Many students will know their credentials without a reminder. Students will also have invites in their inbox to join classes.
2. Students and Parents will have to read and sign the usage contract that details the responsibility of checking out a device. This contract will be available on the school's website for you to print off and return before Monday. We will also have printed contracts in the vestibule at the High School Friday-Sunday (April 3,4,5), from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. We only need the signature page turned in. Place it in the return box at the High School vestibule.
3. Students are welcome to use their own devices. Students do not have to check out a Chromebook on Monday. If you do not check out a Chromebook, you will not have to complete the usage contract. SPS Internet Usage Agreements are applicable with or without school provided equipment.
4. We will begin device check out on Monday. It will be done by class starting with 9th grade at 10:00 am. 10th grade check out will be at 11:00 am. 11th grade will be at 1:00 pm. 12th grade at 2:00 pm. When you arrive at the school stop at the cones in front of the school. When your vehicle is at the cones call the High School at 9189682542 and a device will be brought out and sat on a table if you have a usage contract on file. If not, we will have printed contracts available for you to sign. Please bring your own pen to sign if you need to complete the contract on site.
5. Please understand we are taking measures to eliminate contact with one another. School staff will be wearing gloves and disinfecting as much as possible. When you come to the school you should keep at least 6 feet between you and anyone else you might encounter. Take all the necessary precautions you feel are necessary.
6. Siblings, regardless of class, can pick up a device at the same time.
7. Families without home internet need to communicate with the principal and arrangements will be made to help remove this obstacle. Students will not be penalized and will not get behind because of a lack of access. Time is on our side.
8. The Stroud Public Schools Internet Usage Agreements are applicable with or without school provided equipment. All current students have these on file.
